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# For Grieving Mothers by Dr. Joanne Cacciatore

#### I am a mother.

I am a bereaved mother. My child died, and this is my reluctant path. It is not a path of my choice, but it is a path I must walk mindfully and with intention. It is a journey through the darkest night of my soul and it will take time to wind through the places that scare me.

Every cell in my body aches and longs to be with my beloved child. On days when grief is loud, I may be impatient, distracted, frustrated, and unfocused. I may get angry more easily, or I may seem hopeless. I will shed many, many, many tears. I won't smile as often as my old self. Smiling hurts now.

Most everything hurts some days, even breathing. But please, just sit beside me.

Say nothing.

Do not offer a cure.

Or a pill, or a word, or a potion.

Witness my suffering and don't turn away from me.

Please be gentle with me.

And I will try to be gentle with me too.

I will not ever "get over" my child's death so please don't urge me down that path. Even on days when grief is quiescent, when it isn't standing loudly in the foreground, even

It is Spring once again. A time of renewal and rebirth. It is also a time of re-invention. As those difficult Mother's Day and Father's Day commemorations approach, I am once again shaking my head...this will be my thirtieth Mother's Day without my son. Where did the years go? And who am I now, so different from the woman I was in 1993.

Several years ago, a newly grieving father sat in our circle and plaintively asked when he would be himself again. As if there was ever a possibility of that. I remember the group telling him that while he felt as if he had shattered into a million pieces, time would eventually enable him to "put himself back together". But like a vase that's been glued together, he would always bear the scars of the injury. He would never be like his old self again.

We are always under that pressure. Our families, our friends long for us to recover. They pray we will once again be like our old selves. But we know we never will. We can become a fairly recognizable facsimile...but there will always be the difference between knowing what we now know and the old innocent souls we were.

People still ask innocently, if I have children. I don't hesitate any longer when I tell them my son is dead. They still reel. I don't. They still say, "I don't know how you do it." I still wonder what "it" is that I do. I guess the fact is that I "do" life. What choice do I have? I holed up a long time in my despair. I missed a lot of sunrises and sunsets. Then one day, I felt like Peter was watching me and he wasn't happy. I think I realized then that I was living for two and I made a Herculean effort to re-engage in the world. I'm glad now, that I did. Eternity will come soon enough.

We are a group seeking support in our grief or are able to give it. Among us your religion, your race, your politics, your job or social standing are not important. We care about your grief—the tragedy that each of us have shared—and how we can grow through it, not back to the person we were, but to the person we can become.

on days when I am even able to smile again, the pain is just beneath the surface.

There are days when I still feel paralyzed. My chest feels the sinking weight of my child's absence and, sometimes, I feel as if I will explode from the grief.

Losing my child affects me in so many ways: as a woman, a mother, a human being. It affects every aspect of me: spiritually, physically, mentally, and emotionally. There are days when I barely recognize myself in the mirror anymore.

Grief is as personal to me as my fingerprint. Don't tell me how I should or shouldn't be grieving or that I should or shouldn't "feel better by now." Don't tell me what's right or wrong. I'm doing it my way, in my time. If I am to survive this, I must do what is best for me

My understanding of life will change and a different meaning of life will slowly evolve. What I knew to be true or absolute or real or fair about the world has been challenged so I'm finding my way, moment-to-moment in this new place. Things that once seemed important to me are barely thoughts any longer. I notice life's suffering more- hungry children, the homeless and the destitute, a mother's harsh voice toward her young child- or an elderly person struggling with the door. There are so many things about the world which I now struggle to understand: Why do children die? There are some questions, I've learned, which are simply unanswerable.

So please don't tell me that "God has a plan" for me. This, my friend, is between me and my God. Those platitudes slip far too easily from the mouths of those who tuck their own child into a safe, warm bed at night: Can you begin to imagine your own child, flesh of your flesh, lying lifeless in a casket, when "goodbye" means you'll never see them on this Earth again? Grieving mothers- and fathers- and grandparents- and siblings won't wake up one day with everything 'okay' and life back to normal. I have a new normal now.

As time passes, I may gain gifts, and treasures, and insights but anything gained was too high a cost when compared to what was lost. Perhaps, one day, when I am very, very old, I will say that time has truly helped to heal my broken heart. But always remember that not a second of any minute of any hour of any day passes when I am not aware of the presence of my child's absence, no matter how many years lurk over my shoulder, don't forget that I have another one, another child, whose absence, like the sky, is spread over everything as C.S. Lewis said.

My child may have died; but my love - and my motherhood - never will.

"We know ourselves by the stories we tell. Losing you has dismantled my storyline and shaken my plot; the tale I tell about who I am and where I am going doesn't make sense anymore. I want desperately to find other words that will imagine my life anew. I just don't know where and

how that story will begin."

The Spring used to mock me. In spite of the hurt and anger I felt, the world seemed to leap at the opportunity to heal and regenerate after a cold dark winter. I felt like an outsider everywhere. Winter hung on my soul like a shroud. It's different today. I realize that I have traveled a very great distance from the disconnected, grieving person I was then. Time has indeed made a very big difference. Now I know Peter is with me every day, accompanying me on an imaginable journey, cheering me on, waiting for me, proud of my little successes. I miss his presence, sharing with him, touching him, hearing him laugh, listening to his plans. I wonder always what he would be doing if he were living his life. Would he be married? Where would his career path have taken him by now? What car would he be driving? Where would he be living?

But I look at the wonderful relationships I've developed in the past thirty years as gifts from Peter. Surely it was he who arranged for my friendship with the young couple whose two little children (now grown) I love and refer to as my adopted grandchildren. And certainly it was Peter who maneuvered a young handsome man into our lives, who became like an adopted son to us, complete with the emotional ups and downs of failed romances and the growing pains of early lost love. Tom, now a man in full, married with a young son who calls me Nana.

Now retired and widowed, the garden remains my refuge. It is here, alone with the birds and the bugs, that I am most at peace. I talk to Peter and sometimes I can almost hear him responding. I delight in seeing the garden come back to life. It is a constant in a world rocked by insanity. I grieve for all the newly bereaved parents who must now travel this same path. I am so different from the person I was. I'm more forgiving of those whose challenges often cause them to make poor decisions. And I'm more impatient with those who don't see the "big picture" and squander their precious time as though they had a thousand years to live. Judgmental before my world was rocked, I now feel entitled to my impatience. Now I forgive myself first.

It's Spring. The continuum of life abounds. It seems distinctly possible I've been here before. And just as possible, as the perennials that surround me, I'll be back again.

Dear reader,

I hope you will accept this message I want to share. This year, I am offering myself and all of you a special greeting card. It should arrive sometime in the Spring. It is sent with love and compassion, solidarity and sadness, and acceptance of what was, and steadfastness in honoring what always will be. It should arrive special delivery, and will be labeled confidential and personal, sensitive material, not appropriate for the general population. I hope it will bring comfort and support.

This greeting card is designed for Bereaved Parents during this highly emotionally charged period between Mother's Day and Father's Day. It is a decidedly non-commercial, non-cheery missive dedicated to a group, often isolated and invisible, at no time so strikingly outcast as during this interval when it seems the whole American and media marketplace is obsessed with a public celebration of parenthood. The cards, the flowers, the department store advertisements describing perfect presents for smiling moms and proud dads from loving (and of course, living) off-spring make this month long shoperama more like a painful, money-making marathon than a silly, shallow, Hallmark moment.

I fear an unpleasant tone may be seeping into my message, which is definitely not my goal. Still, even as the years pass, and the truth that our children are no longer physically part of our existence necessarily integrates into our consciousness, we never truly become comfortable with that incomprehensible reality. know that on the surface, time moves on with its rhythm and busyness, but on a deeper level, there is always the awareness that I lost my child. I try to practice an attitude of gratitude for the gift of my wonderful son's life, cut short well before his journey on this earth should have ended. But, admittedly, at times, my inner feelings of being cheated, unjustly treated and defeated by life, manifests. This negativity can reveal itself in gallows humor satirizing the superficial complaints of clueless (regular) people, unresolved guilt (even though I do not have control over death), a sense of being viewed as a pariah or object of pity example, when I answer the innocuous query, How many children do you have?, the permanent status of grief as part of my psychic makeup.

In an effort to endure this difficult season, I've decided to give my-self and all my compassionate friends a BP (bereaved parents) card. No sentimental images, specious verse, cutesy musical ditties, or inspirational messages to be included. No price tag listed on the bottom of the back page. No postage stamp necessary. Just an affirmation that we sill are mothers and fathers; that our children will always be with us in spirit; that our sons and daughters are loved and missed; that their lives mattered; that their memories are a blessing; that they continue to enrich and ennoble our lives every single day of the year. They bequeath to each of us, uniquely and distinctively, their Mother's Day and Father's Day wishes, in a profound, mystical and transcendent way.

BP cards are for our hearts only. They are our silent, inexplicable and inalienable legacy.

They say this pain will lessen, that in time I will find peace, that these mighty waves of anguish will someday lighten, cease.

## **Siblings**

#### Disenfranchised grief

The loss of an adult sibling is often a significant one. I have had the privilege, of companioning many mourners who have experienced the death of a sibling, and they have taught me that they often feel deep pain and a profound sense of loss. Perhaps this resonates with you and your experience.

Yet too often, our society views the death of an adult sibling as less important than the death of a spouse, a child, a parent or even a close friend. This results in surviving siblings feeling unvalidated and unsupported in their grief. We sometimes call this "disenfranchised grief", meaning that it is not acknowledged in our culture. I also use the term "forgotten mourners" to describe this problem. Has this happened to you?

The truth is, no losses are "less than." They are simply different. What's more, the stronger your attachment to someone who dies, the stronger your grief is likely to be – no matter the type of relationship (spouse, child, parent, sibling, friend, etc.). Also, when relationships are strained, difficult or have been cut off, we often experience natural complications because we mourn for what we wish could have been.

If you are feeling disenfranchised in your grief over the loss of your sibling, you can choose to get the support you need. First, talk to your spouse, your children and your best friends about your thoughts and feelings. Tell them that you are struggling and that you need their help. Many people are willing and able to be supportive if only they are made aware that support is needed.

Second, seek out others who have experienced the death of a sibling. You will probably find that they understand your grief and are willing to talk to you about theirs. Some of these people may even help form a support group that you can participate in.

And third, consider seeing a grief counselor if support among your friends and family is lacking. Many (though not all) grief counselors understand that adult sibling loss can be just as difficult as other types of loss, and their compassionate support suring your grief journey can make all the difference.
